Krishnan Srinivasan is a senior road safety consultant with the World Bank in India, with more than twenty years of experience in transport infrastructure development and regulation across eight countries including the USA and India. Over the last decade and half, he has helped evolve transportation solutions to India and other nations in the South Asian region, playing key roles toward formulation of new legislation (including the Motor Vehicles Amendment Act, 2019) and policy dictating safer roads and vehicles. He has also supported iRAP assessments in India and Vietnam and helped train officials in India, Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan. Currently, he supports projects of the World Bank and other entities in India, Bangladesh, Nepal and Sri Lanka on road safety management, formulation of programs/policies/strategies/action plans, safe systems, crash data management and engineering and econometric assessments to improve road user safety.

Mr. Srinivasan holds an MBA from the University of Virginia's Darden School of Business Administration, a Master's Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Cincinnati, and a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering from Osmania University.
