Traffic Calming Measures for
Enhancing Safety

Dr S M Sarin is a Civil Engineering graduate from Jodhpur University, with Masters in Highway Engineering from University of Roorkee (now IIT Roorkee) and commenced his career as Lecturer in Highway engineering at Roorkee itself. He later joined the Central Road Research Institute, New Delhi as Scientist in Traffic Engineering Division in 1969. He received the Commonwealth Scholarship from Government of UK in 1970 and did his MSc (in Traffic Engineering) and PhD (in Transportation and Environment Planning) from University of Birmingham. He was instrumental in setting up of the Department of Road Safety and Environment at CRRI in 1986 which he headed from its inception till his retirement in 2000.

Dr Sarin worked as Consultant on various World Bank and ADB Projects related to Road Safety within India and abroad in countries like Laos, Vietnam, Nepal and Tajikistan. He served as Director (Road Safety) at Asian Institute of Transport Development (AITD) during 2017-19 and handled Road Safety Training Programmes all over India under a World Bank sponsored Project of MoRTH.
