A distinguished Alumnus of AIIMS, New Delhi, Dr. Sunil Kumar is a General Surgeon by Training. In his career spanning over three and a half decades, he has held several key positions in the Govt. of Delhi which include Professor and Medical Director at GTB Hospital and UCMS, Director (IHBAS), Director (RGSSH) and Regional Director (RDHS-East). Under his leadership both GTB and IHBAS achieved third spot in the Government's KAYAKALP Program.

With his specialization in Surgery encompassing Trauma, Laparoscopy, Thoracic (non-cardiac) and Hepato-biliary-pancreatic streams, he has guided a large number of Post Graduates in surgery. His achievements include contribution in Laparoscopic surgery and Trauma Surgery as WHO Fellow in UK and Australia. A strong proponent of Programme-Academic Interface, he has published over 85 research articles in national and international journals.

Presently Dr. Sunil Kumar is Director-General of Health Services, MoH&FW, and he is instrumental in bringing about transparency and efficiency in working of the Directorate of Health Services through ongoing reforms.
