Earlier, he has worked as CGM (Tech) and Regional Officer-Chennai and handled work related to planning, construction, operation, and management of about 2,000 km long NHs in Chennai region.

He has also worked as Team Leader for both Indian and overseas consultancy assignments, and conducted a number of Management Development Programmes in Transport Sector, Road Safety and Aviation Planning as Head-Research Consultancy Division Faculty Member, Central Institute of Road Transport (CIRT), Pune.
