Mr Bhanot is having double Engineering degree and Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Management, and MBA from FMS Delhi. Mr. Bhanot is the former Director of Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI). He was also the DDG in the Department of Heavy Industries and headed the Technical Wing to participate in UNECE WP-29, which prescribes global regulations for automobile.

He was the Chairman of Transport Engineering Divisional Council (TEDC) of BIS. He was also the founder Chairman of CMVR-Technical Standing Committee. Mr. Bhanot was also the chairman of the committee for finalizing the Bus and Truck Body code for the country and he was India's first Electronics Adviser in EEC at Brussels during 1978-1983. He served in numerous committees for developing standards related to automobiles in the country.

Mr. Bhanot is the Chairman of TED 31 dealing with I&C regime for motor vehicles in the country. Mr. Bhanot has been conferred the prestigious Prince Michael International Road Safety Award, SAE International Award for safety regulations on CNG buses, Golden Peacock Award for Quality management and also the Life Time Achievement Award in 2015 by SAE India Foundation.
