Shri Satyendra Garg joined Indian Police Service in 1987 and was allotted AGUMT Cadre. His educational qualifications are M.A. (History), L.L. B. Shri Garg served in Delhi, Goa, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, and Andaman & Nicobar in various capacities in the State and UT Police and on Central deputation with Government of India.

He was awarded Indian Police Medal for Meritorious Services on Republic Day, 2008 and President's Police Medal for Distinguished Services in January 2016, apart from Duty Medals for working in Arunachal Pradesh and Mizoram and Governor's Gold Medal on Independence Day, 1993.

As Joint Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Delhi from January 2010 to January 2013 he ensured world class traffic arrangements for Commonwealth Games 2010. He worked for and reduced road fatalities for three years in Delhi. His work on drunken driving, road safety and other initiatives became examples for traffic police in other cities of India.

As officiating Director General of Police, Arunachal Pradesh he ensured most peaceful, fair and impartial Parliamentary and Assembly elections in the State in May June 2014.

He served as Joint Secretary (North-East), Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi for five years from 2015 to 2020. As JS (NE), MHA he contributed in reduction of insurgency incidents, reduction in civilian and Armed Forces deaths in North East States. He was instrumental in bringing normalcy in Northeastern states through peace talks and signed Agreements on behalf of Government of India with militant outfits including Bodo Peace Accord of January, 2020.

After completing five years central deputation in MHA, he worked as Director General of Police, Andaman & Nicobar Islands from December 2020 to April 2022. He superannuated from Indian Police Service in June 2022 as Special Commissioner of Police, Training, Delhi Police.
