

Mr. R.K. Pandey**Former Member (Engineering), NHAI**

Mr. R.K. Pandey recently retired as Member (Projects) from National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). He joined the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways as an Assistant Executive Engineer in 1986 through the Central Engineering Services. He had worked in various capacities in the Ministry and rose to the position of Chief Engineer in September 2011. He also served NHAI as a Chief General Manager. During September 2009 to September 2011, he became Chief Engineer in the Ministry.
